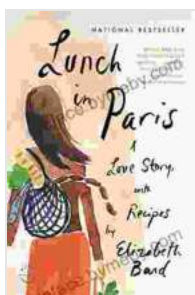

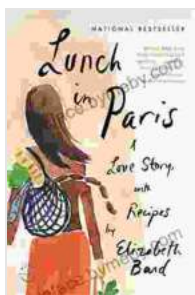
Elizabeth Bard is an American author, chef, and food blogger. She is the author of the memoir **Lunch in Paris**, which was a **New York Times** bestseller.
